
DIRECTIONS

Eagle Eyrie Baptist Conference Center

1 Eagle Eyrie Dr, Lynchburg, VA 24503

FROM US-220 N:

- 1. Take exit 4E for US-460 E/Orange Ave
- 2. Merge onto US-460 E/Orange Ave NE 25.9 mi
- 3. Keep right to continue on US-460 E/US-460 BYP E 2.8 mi
- 4. Take the State Rte 714 exit toward US-221 N/VA-122 N – 0.1 mi
- 5. Follow VA-122 N to US-501 S in Big Island 24 min (19.2 mi)
- 6. Turn left onto State Rte 714 0.1 mi
- 7. Turn right onto Independence Blvd 1.7 mi
- 8. Continue onto VA-122 N/Longwood Ave 17.4 mi
- 9. Turn right onto US-501 S 10 min (7.2 mi)
- 10. Turn left onto Eagle Eyrie Dr (Destination will be on the right) 1 min (0.1 mi)





Nestled on top of Locke Mountain, Eagle Eyrie is a premiere conference center located on 425 peaceful, wooded acres near the beautiful Blue Ridge Parkway. Just 12 miles from downtown Lynchburg, the conference center is only a short distance away from many tourist attractions and local colleges and universities.

Most lodges provide either single or bunk bed-style accommodations; few lodges have double beds. All lodges are central air-conditioned and heated, have full kitchens (should you want to prepare your own meals), are equipped with living and dining areas large enough to accommodate their capacity, and can handle both guests on different hallways and separate bathrooms. Most lodges have screened porches to enjoy the wooded surroundings as well as views of the mountains.
